BE READY.

Visit *NMVOTE.ORG* to register to vote, update your voter registration, or check your current voter registration. Don't want to do it online? Come by or give the County Clerk's Office a call! We can mail you a voter registration form or check your current voter registration for you if you are already registered! *Party changes must be made by May 7, 2024.

*New Mexico has a closed primary, so only those registered in a major political party (Democrat, Republican, Libertarian) may participate in Primary Elections.

VOTER REGISTRATION

Mail-in & online voter registration close May 7th. Register to vote or update an existing registration in person during early voting, *prior* to voting, at any early voting location & on Election Day from 7am-7pm at any polling location.

Requirements for same day voter registration

A physical form of identification issued by the federal or state government and that:

- Contains the name of the qualified elector;

 AND
- Contains a photograph of the qualified elector;
 AND
- Shall contain an address matching the address provided for the registration <u>OR</u> be accompanied by a utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other document issued by an educational institution or government, dated within 90 days, containing the name of the qualified elector & an address matching the address provided for the registration.



Not sure you will be in town to vote in person? Visit NMVOTE.ORG and request your absentee ballot or give the County Clerk's Office a call to have an application mailed to you.

BE PREPARED.

May 7th-first day ballots can be mailed
May 21st-last day to request ballot
Ballots must be received by the
County Clerk's office no later than
7 pm on June 4th.



Want to vote absentee every election without having to request a ballot each time? Ask to be placed on the permanent absentee ballot list!
