The Board of Chaves County Commissioners held a special commission meeting at the Chaves County Adult Detention Center in Roswell, New Mexico. Chairman Duffey called the meeting to order at 9:00a.m. Those present were Commissioners Duffey, Wooton, Corn, Chesser and Nibert. Also present were County Manager Stan Riggs, Public Services Director Sonny Chancey, Detention Administrator Clay Corn, Finance Director Joe Sedillo, Former County Commissioner Alice Eppers, County Clerk Dave Kunko, news media, staff and guests.

Commissioner Wooton led the Pledge of Allegiance and Commissioner Chesser led in prayer.

CHAVES COUNTY ADULT DETENTION CENTER TOUR

Sonny Chancey introduced Raul Perea as the Construction Superintendent for the CCDC Project from Bradbury and Stamm. He took us on a tour of the project and we went through all the new construction as well as part of the original building near the central control room. Mr. Perea stated that he currently has 70 to 75 workers on the project each day. In addition to his work crew there are approximately 7 subcontractors on site as well. It was stated that current capacity of the facility is 267. Once the project is completed the facility will hold up to 400 inmates.

Chairman Duffey adjourned the meeting at 10:32a.m.
