

# FINAL BUDGET IN BRIEF FY 2025 "Committing to Strategic Evaluations that Produce Successful Results"

**GENERAL OPERATING BUDGET: Main operating budget for Chaves County** 

CHAVES COUNTY IS PROJECTING \$38.31M OF REVENUE IN FY2025, WHICH REPRESENTS A 4.3% INCREASE OVER THE PRIOR YEAR. BUDGETED EXPENDITURES ARE PROJECTED TO INCREASE BY 7.2% TO \$41.15M IN FY2025

ALL FUNDS: All funds that Chaves County will oversee including grants, volunteer fire departments, restricted federal money, etc,

CHAVES COUNTY IS PROJECTING \$61.84M OF REVENUE IN FY2025, WHICH REPRESENTS A .5% DECREASE OVER THE PRIOR YEAR. BUDGETED EXPENDITURES ARE PROJECTED TO INCREASE BY 3.7% TO \$76.4M IN FY2025.

Chaves County has 23,280 Total Households contributing to the \$11M in Property Tax and \$17M GRT Revenue for the General Operating Budget Chaves County oversees

Where does Chaves County's Citizen's Dollar go to for Main Operating Budget??

OUT OF \$1, 45 CENTS GOES TO PUBLIC SAFETY, 25 CENTS TO PUBLIC WORKS AND 30 CENTS TO GENERAL GOVERNMENT. IT IS BROKEN DOWN AS FOLLOWS:

## Who is Chaves County?

Chaves County is in southeast New Mexico and was created by Territorial Legislature on February 25, 1889 Chaves County is a center for irrigated farms, farming, dairy production, ranching, manufacturing, distribution and petroleum production

The governance is established by a fivemember Board of Commissioners operating with a commissionermanager relationship. The executive function is further divided to five elected county officials-Assessor, Treasurer, Clerk, Sheriff and Probate Judge. Services provided include roads, sanitation, health and social services, public safety, (sheriff, fire, emergency communications, corrections and detention), public improvement projects, planning and zoning, administrative services and economic development.
