The Board of Chaves County Commissioners held a special commission meeting in the Commission Chamber of the Joe Skeen Building, #1 St. Mary's Place in Roswell, New Mexico. Chairman Duffey called the meeting to order at 5:00p.m. Those present were Commissioners Duffey, Corn, Chesser and Wooton. Commissioner Cavin joined the meeting by telephone. Also present were County Manager Stan Riggs, Public Services Director Sonny Chancey, Finance Director Joe Sedillo, Chief Deputy Sheriff Shane Baker, County Clerk Dave Kunko, news media, staff and guests.

Commissioner Wooton led the Pledge of Allegiance and Commissioner Chesser led in prayer.

PROCLAMATION

Commissioner Corn read a proclamation for National Service Recognition Day, April 7, 2015.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

AMENDMENTS TO ORDINANCES O-089, O-090, O-091, DEDICATING COUNTY HOLD HARMLESS GROSS RECEIPTS TAXES AND ORDINANCE O-094.

Stan Riggs stated that the amendments and the new ordinance were not necessary because the legislation that would have required this action did not pass. This action was put into motion in case the legislation affecting our hold harmless gross receipts taxes had passed. Commissioner Corn stated he did not believe this would come up again because there now are many counties and municipalities taking similar action. Commissioner Corn moved to table the amendments to Ordinances O-089, O-090, O-091 and Ordinance O-094. Commissioner Chesser seconded the motion. A voice vote was unanimous and the motion carried.

ITB-15-1 – UNIFORMS FOR THE CHAVES COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

Mr. Chancey stated the County solicited bids for uniforms for the Sheriff's Office. He stated only one bid was received and it was from Neve's Uniforms of Albuquerque. Commissioner Wooton moved to award Bid ITB-15-1 to Neve's Uniforms. Commissioner Corn seconded the motion. Chief Deputy Baker stated these prices were very competitive and Neve's is a New Mexico vendor. A voice vote was unanimous and the motion carried.
