Chaves County received a total of sixteen road hearing documents for 2018. All of the documents were for road vacations. Seven applications came from Chaves County Landowners, and nine were requested by the Chaves County Road Department. On Wednesday March 7, 2018 the Chaves County Board of Freeholders went for site visits at each of this year's requested road vacation locations. In every instance the Freeholders voted unanimously for their final recommendations. Please accept the following summary.

Summary of Freeholder Reports

Applications with DO NOT Vacate Recommendation from Freeholders

Road Vacation Application #1-Felix Canyon Road: Steven Ellyson is requesting the vacation of 2.37 miles of C4-042 at the far west end of road. Freeholders recommended that this application be rejected because it provides primary access to Public Lands. They recommend that this section of road **NOT** be vacated.

Road Vacation Application #3-Caddo Road: Terry Bogle is requesting the vacation of 1 mile of C3-070 between Vineyard and Cherokee Roads. Freeholders recommended that this application be rejected because it is a route used by farmers, commuters, and emergency responders. They recommend that this section of road **NOT** be vacated.

Road Vacation Application #5-Picacho Road: Helen Henderson is requesting the vacation of 5 miles of C4-033 from the Chaves County line south to their property line. Freeholders recommended that this application be rejected because it is a route with frequent, daily use by numerous ranchers, hunters, commuters and emergency responders for commerce between Lincoln and Chaves Counties. They recommend that this section of road **NOT** be vacated.

Road Vacation Application #7-Picacho/Felix Canyon Road: H. C. Hendricks is requesting the vacation of 4.77 miles of C4-042. Officially, this east to west section of road is Felix Canyon Road, however it is often called Picacho Road as well. Freeholders recommended that this application be rejected because it provides primary access to public lands and is a route with frequent, daily use by numerous ranchers, hunters, commuters and emergency responders for commerce between Lincoln and Chaves Counties and US highways 70 and 82. They recommend that this section of road **NOT** be vacated.

Applications with VACATE Recommendation from Freeholders

Road Vacation Application #2-Chickasaw Road: Cliff Waide is requesting the vacation of 1.54 miles of C3-014 west from the intersection of Quail Road. This road does not benefit the county, is used only by the rancher and does not deny any access to public lands. Freeholders recommended that this road be vacated.

Road Vacation Application #4-Chickasaw Road: BNSF is requesting the vacation of .45 mile of C3-014 from the Old Dexter Highway to the locked gate east of the railroad track. This road does not benefit the county and BNSF is closing the crossing. Freeholders recommended that this road be vacated.

Road Vacation Application #6-East Mescalero Road: Tom Conlee is requesting the vacation of .26 mile of C1-140 from the east end west to the railroad track. This road is not County Maintained, 200 foot is being used as a private driveway and the remainder is blocked by a berm. Freeholders recommended that this road be vacated.

Road Vacation Application #8-and #9 Ogalalla and Natchez Road: Chaves County is withdrawing their applications for these two roads.

Road Vacation Application #10-Raleigh Road: Chaves County is requesting the vacation of .45 mile of C3-145. This road is a driveway serving one property. Freeholders recommended that this road be vacated.

Road Vacation Application #11-Pack Road: Chaves County is requesting the vacation of .26 mile of C1-176. This road is a driveway serving one property. Freeholders recommended that this road be vacated.

Road Vacation Application #12-Joy Road: Chaves County is requesting the vacation of .5 mile of Joy Road. This road does not benefit the county. Freeholders recommended that this road be vacated.

Road Vacation Application #13-Gloria Road: Chaves County is requesting the vacation of .59 mile of C3-024. This road is a driveway serving one property. Freeholders recommended that this road be vacated.

Road Vacation Application #14-Sharon Road: Chaves County is requesting the vacation of .15 mile of C3-159. This road is a driveway serving one property. It is behind a locked gate. Freeholders recommended that this road be vacated.

Road Vacation Application #15-Tabitha Road: Chaves County is requesting the vacation of .15 mile of C3-158. This road is a driveway serving one property. It is behind a locked gate. Freeholders recommended that this road be vacated.

Road Vacation Application #16-Ursula Road: Chaves County is requesting the vacation of .15 mile of C3-155. This road is a driveway serving one property. It is behind a locked gate. Freeholders recommended that this road be vacated.

STAFF REVIEW Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance 2018-01

The subject property is located at 409 Sacaton Street and is described as Lots C1-C3, Block 2 of Wheeler Subdivision. It is approximately 0.41 acres in size. The request is for a Variance to the Chaves County Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance to allow a structure to be located in the floodway.

Section 4.5.2 of the Ordinance states: Variances may be issued for new construction and substantial improvements to be erected on a lot of one-half acre or less in size contiguous to and surrounded by lots with existing structures constructed below the base flood elevation provided items in Section 4.3.2 have been fully considered. Additionally, 4.5.4 states: Variances shall not be issued within any designated floodway if any increase in flood levels during the base flood discharge would result.

There a numerous lots around this property with established homes that are below the Base Flood Elevation, including a number within the floodway as well. The referenced property is also less than one half acre in size. Thus, the situation meets the base requirements of Section 4.5.2. In addition, replacing one manufactured home with another at the same, or higher, floor elevation would logically not increase any flood level to meet the requirements of Section 4.5.4.

- 4.3.2 states: Approval of denial of a floodplain use permit shall be based on all the provisions of this Ordinance and the following relevant factors.
- a,) the danger to life and property due to flooding or erosion damage;
- b.) the susceptibility of the proposed facility and its contents to flood damage and the effect of such damage on the individual owner;
- c.) the danger that materials will be swept onto other lands to the injury of others:
- d.) the compatibility of the proposed use with existing and anticipated development;
- e.) the safety of access to the property in times of flood for ordinary and emergency vehicles;
- f.) the costs of providing governmental services during and after flood conditions including maintenance and repair of streets and bridges, and public utilities and facilities such as sewer, gas, electrical and water systems; (The use of the property will not change for a.- f.)
- g.) the expected heights, velocity, duration, rate of rise, and sediment transport of the flood waters expected at the site; (This is on the edge of the flood way and there is no record of water ever getting near this property.)
- h.) the availability of alternative locations, not subject to flooding or erosion damage, for the proposed use; (There are no alternatives for this property owner.)
- i.) the relationship of the proposed us to the comprehensive plan for the area; (The area is designated for residential development.)

The Flood Insurance Rate Map Number is 35005C1357D, dated September 25, 2009. The Base Flood Elevation (BFE) at the location of the existing home is 3584'. The elevation of existing grade is 3580'. The site is on the edge of the flood way, about 700 feet west of the main drainage channel.

This is existing development that will be economically enhanced, which will also benefit the neighborhood. There is no record of flooding of this property. There are seven other homes in the floodway in the immediate vicinity and several more in the floodplain, below the base flood elevation.

The Chaves County Commissioners shall hear and render judgement on requests for variances from the requirements of this Ordinance. Variances shall only be issued upon:

- 1.) A determination that the variance is the minimum necessary, considering the flood hazard, to afford relief; (There will be no change in the existing structure elevations.)
- 2.) That good and sufficient cause has been shown; (This will allow for a beneficial use of the property that increases property values.)
- 3.) That failure to grant the variance would result in exceptional hardship to the applicant; (The property will have less and declining value if not approved, and the potential flood hazard will not be changed.) and,
- 4.) That granting of a variance will not result in increased flood heights, additional threats to public safety, extraordinary public expense, create nuisance, cause fraud or victimization of the public or conflict with existing local laws or ordinances. (There will be no increase in flood height, there will be no additional threats to public safety, no extraordinary public expense, no creation of nuisances, will not cause fraud or victimization of the public and will not conflict with any other existing local laws or ordinances.)

Because this represents essentially no physical change in conditions, Staff recommends approval of this request with the following stipulations:

1. That the improvements be as proposed and no more without further review;



The Regular Meeting of the Chaves County Planning & Zoning Commission was held in the Commission Chambers at the Chaves County Administrative Center on April 3, 2018 beginning at 5:45PM.

Minutes

The minutes of the January 2, 2018 meeting were approved unanimously as submitted.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Case Z 2018-1

Request for a Special Use Permit to allow an aggregate crushing and an asphalt hot mix plant on property described as part of the SW1/4 of Section 34, T13S, R25E, on E. Chickasaw Rd., Hagerman

Marlin Johnson began the Staff Report by stating that the subject property was located on the north side of Chickasaw Road, approximately one half mile east of Highway 285, and is part of a very large agricultural parcel. The applicant desires a Special Use Permit for an aggregate crushing operation and an asphalt hot mix plant.

There are no homes between the site and Highway 285. The nearest homes are about a mile away. East Chickasaw is a county maintained road and the site is in close proximity to State Highway 285. The site may only be needed for a year or two and should have minimal impact on neighboring properties and the general public. It may well be a benefit to the public from an economical perspective.

There have been no concerns raised by any department or agencies. There have been no comments from the general public.

Staff recommends approval with the following stipulations:

- 1.) That the Special Use Permit be for up to a three (3) year period;
- 2.) That an administrative review may be conducted to consider an extension should there be a written request to continue the operation longer;
- 3.) That all State and Federal regulations be met and maintained; and
- 4.) That any lighting used in conjunction with this use be shielded from surrounding existing and future residential uses and be night sky sensitive;

Findings of Fact could include: the use is only temporary and not a change of zoning for permanent use; the location will not cause concerns for neighbors or the general public; there are no objections from nearby landowners or the public; appropriate conditions and safeguards are imposed to protect the general plan and to conserve and protect the property values in the neighborhood

Chair Rogers asked if there was anyone wishing to speak in favor or against the application.

Jana Lessard introduced herself as the Project Manager for J&H Services. They believe that the hot plant will be an economic benefit to Chaves County. Ms. Lessard would appreciate approval of their permit.

Commissioner Morley asked if they have a specific project they're working on and if two (2) years was adequate.

Ms. Lessard mentioned a couple of active projects in Chaves County and Eddy County. The company's current plan is two years.

Nobody else spoke in favor nor against the application.

Commissioner Wagner made a motion to recommend approval of Case Z 2018-1 as submitted including the Conditions of Approval and Findings of Fact. Commissioner Morley seconded the motion. Motion carried by a 3-0 vote. This case is scheduled to be heard by the Chaves County Board of Commissioners on April 19, 2018 at 9 a.m.

2. Case Z 2018-2

Request for a Rezone to Industrial to allow parking of semi-trucks on property described as Parcel A2 S28 T14S R25E Cherry Section 28 Exemption Survey S22-17, on Bronzite Rd. in Hagerman

Marlin Johnson began the Staff Report by stating that the subject property was located south of 7956 Bronzite Road, about three-quarters of a mile south of Sagebrush Valley Road and is 40 acres in size. The applicant desires to rezone to Industrial District for parking for a small trucking business. The property is currently zoned Agricultural.

The nearest residence is about 1000 feet to the north. Other residences are nearly three-quarters of a mile away. Access is via Bronzite Road, a private road that extends south from Sagebrush Valley Road/State Highway 13.

There is an approved Special Use Permit for a recreational facility on the property to the north and there is Commercial Zoning a quarter mile to the north. All other nearby zoning is Agricultural. If more Commercial and/or Industrial zoning and uses are established in the area, the recreational property could become zoned Commercial and not require a Special Use Permit.

No objections have been received from County Departments or from other agencies. There has been no objection from nearby landowners, though there has been an inquiry.

The Comprehensive Land Use Plan calls for Commercial and/or Industrial zoning for properties along the Highway 285 corridor. This property is not directly on the corridor but is within 500 feet of the highway, does fall within the corridor and is adjacent to a parcel that abuts Highway 285.

Access to Bronzite Road is excellent as Sagebrush Valley Road is a State Highway and Bronzite Road is only 1000 feet from State Highway 285. However, Bronzite Road is a private road, not maintained and only lightly developed. This represents the good and the bad of the subject property regarding access as there could be some issues with the private road, like dust and maintenance. However, that will be true regardless of the types of development that will occur along this three mile long road.

There is a need for areas that can be zoned for these types of industrial uses, particularly small to medium size trucking operations and perhaps oil field service businesses as well. A potential upside could be that businesses establishing along Bronzite Road might, over time, upgrade the road for their own needs.

If the rezone to Industrial District for a trucking operation is approved, Staff recommends the following conditions:

- 1.) That the driveway and parking areas be graveled in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance;
- 2.) That a hard surface pad, concrete or asphalt, be installed and used for any maintenance operations, and that a catch basin be installed for any fluids, if necessary;
- 3.) That all State and Federal regulations be met and maintained; and
- 4.) That any lighting used in conjunction with this use be shielded from surrounding existing and future residential uses and be night sky sensitive;

Findings of Fact could include: the Comprehensive Plan supports industrial uses along Highway 285 and this location is within that corridor and adjacent to the parcel that abuts the Highway; there is an existing recreational use north of the subject property; there is Commercial Zoning nearby; there is a substantial distance from the proposed business location to existing residences; there are no objections from the neighborhood; conditions of approval will limit negative impacts on surrounding properties; the use or value of the area adjacent to the property will not be affected substantially in an adverse manner;

If the rezone to Industrial District is denied:

Findings of Fact could include: there are objections to the use that cannot be adequately mitigated through conditions of approval; access issues are deemed unfavorable and inadequate for this use

Commissioner Wagner asked Mr. Johnson if this was the same property discussed a few months ago with a trucking business on it. Mr. Johnson responded that it was the same applicants, but different property.

Commissioner Morley wanted to know if the recommendation was for a temporary request. Mr. Johnson responded that if the application is approved, it will be approved as a rezone to Industrial. The property is within a corridor along Hwy. 285 where the Comprehensive Plan supports Commercial/Industrial zoning. Since there are already at least 2 commercial properties nearby, the Board of Commissioners could be setting a precedent in this area when they vote on the application on April 19, 2018.

Commissioner Morley asked if the applicants would be limited in the number of trucks. Mr. Johnson indicated that the reason there is no limit is that this corridor is where it is appropriate to have light Industrial and Commercial zoning. The difference between this application and others in the past, is that the Chaves County Comprehensive Plan supports this type of use along the corridor of Hwy. 285.

Chair Rogers asked if there was anyone wishing to speak in favor of the application.

Yolanda Martinez (with the assistance of Julia Torres as translator), introduced herself. They would like to have the property rezoned to be able to park their trucks there.

Commissioner Wagner wanted to know how many trucks they would like to have on the property. Mrs. Martinez responded they currently have four (4) trucks on their property.

Commissioner Morley commented that he would prefer that the application be approved on a temporary basis since the properties there are currently zoned agricultural/residential. If the County decides not to rezone to industrial, property owners who bought properties for residential purposes would not be affected by an industrial operation.

Commissioner Wagner mentioned that, if he understood correctly, this area is where the County would like to rezone to Commercial/Industrial. Mr. Johnson responded that this is where the Comprehensive Plan supports this type of zoning.

Commissioner Wagner asked Mr. Johnson if the P&Z Commission could pass this on to the Chaves County Board of Commissioners without any recommendation from them. Mr. Johnson indicated that it was possible but that it would be more of a situation where there was no motion by the P&Z Commission.

Commissioner Wagner expressed his concern with the situation where the County is wanting to have this area be rezoned to Commercial/Industrial and somebody is currently selling nearby properties for residential purposes. He doesn't understand how anyone would want to buy residential properties in an area that the County might rezone to Commercial/Industrial.

Mr. Johnson responded that the reason for tonight's hearing was so that the County could begin to set the trend and decide what they want the future development along Bronzite Rd. to be.

Commissioner Wagner wondered how it would be possible to distinguish between Commercial/ Industrial properties and residential properties when they are being sold. Mr. Johnson stated that the County couldn't make that decision for the person selling the properties but did mention that that person had signed this application.

Commissioner Wagner did not have a problem recommending approval of this case, but at the same time did not want someone to come back later and complain that they invested their life savings on a residential property and have a commercial/industrial zoned property next door.

Mr. Johnson responded that it would be up to the seller to disclose this information to potential buyers. Notification letters were sent to all of the property owners on Bronzite Rd. so they would have an opportunity to comment.

Commissioner Morley agreed that the current property owner, Mrs. Marshall Decker would have to disclose the information to future buyers, but the fact was that she has already sold properties out there for residential purposes. He mentioned that at one time or another there will be issues relating to dust, water, and road conditions. Commissioner Morley also commented the possibility of someone complaining to the County about having a trucking operation next door when they bought their property for residential purposes.

Mr. Johnson thought this was good discussion. Once again he stated that this property makes more sense for a trucking operation because it fits the Comprehensive Plan and because there is currently very limited residential properties nearby.

Commissioner Morley agreed that the County needs to have a place for these trucking operations, but he has a problem approving them on properties that are not currently zoned for that use. He stated that he would prefer to approve this application on a temporary basis and limit the number of trucks.

Mr. Johnson responded that approving the application for a limited amount of time does not match the intent of industrial zoning. The application could be approved as a Special Use Permit but that would create a burden on the potential buyers because they are investing in an unknown. On the other hand, limitation requirements could be added to the industrial zoning.

Commissioner Wagner asked Mr. Johnson if this could get approved as light industrial. Mr. Johnson responded that that type of zoning did not exist in our Ordinance, but that limitations could be added to the stipulations under industrial zoning.

Commissioner Wagner made a motion to recommend approval of Case Z 2018-2 as submitted including the Conditions of Approval and Findings of Fact. Commissioner Morley seconded the motion. Motion carried by a 3-0 vote. This case is scheduled to be heard by the Chaves County Board of Commissioners on April 19, 2018 at 9 a.m.

Mr. Johnson appreciated the discussion on this case. He pointed to the fact that he did not make a recommendation either way on this case, because this will be adding to the Comprehensive Land Use Plan to make a decision about the future of this particular area and the time is right to make that decision.



THIS AMENDMENT, hereinafter referred to as the "Amendment", is made and entered into by and between the Department of Finance and Administration, State of New Mexico, acting through the Local Government Division, Suite 202, Bataan Memorial Building, Santa Fe, New Mexico, 87501, hereinafter referred to as the "Division", and <u>Chaves County</u>, hereinafter referred to as the "Grantee", as of the date this Amendment is executed by the Division.

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2017, the DWI Grant Council awarded the Grantee \$35,000.00 to support programs to reduce the incidence of driving while intoxicated, alcoholism, and alcohol abuse in New Mexico ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Grantee and the Division entered into a grant agreement, effective July 1, 2017, in the amount of \$35,000.00 to administer the Project ("Grant Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, on November 2, 2017, the DWI Grant Council awarded the Grantee \$14,926.00 of Fiscal Year 2017 reverted distribution funds to supplement the Grant Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Grantee and the Division entered into a grant agreement amendment no 1, effective January 4, 2018 in the amount of \$49,926.00 to administer the Project ("Grant Amendment No. 1"); and

WHEREAS, as a part of the Grant Agreement, the Grantee shall budget and expend a minimum of ten percent of the total DWI grant funding award for the twelve-month period in local match/in-kind monies. The Grantee shall not budget administrative expenses except as in-kind match pursuant to the DWI Grant Council's administrative policy. The Grantee hereby budgeted \$13,000.00 (26%) as its matching funds commitment.

WHEREAS, the Grantee has requested an adjustment to increase the In-kind budget for the Project as follows: increase the Contractual Services In-kind category by \$6,000.00 (revising from \$0.00 to \$6,000.00); and increasing the Screening component by \$6,000.00 (revising from \$0.00 to \$6,000.00); and to increase the total In-kind budget by \$6,000.00 (revising from \$13,000.00 to \$19,000.00) (38%); as it's matching funds commitment; and

WHEREAS, the Grantee and the Division desire to memorialize through this Amendment the terms and conditions upon which the budget adjustment will be executed.

AGREEMENT

ORDINANCE NO. 0-099

REGULATING THE USE OF OFF-HIGHWAY MOTOR VEHICLES ON COUNTY ROADS

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Legislature created the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Act, Section 66-3-1001, NMSA, 1978, which allows County's to authorize by ordinance the use of off-highway motor vehicles on county roads.

WHEREAS, allowing off-highway motor vehicles to use county roads will assist the Agriculture industry and will promote recreation in the county.

WHEREAS, the County desires to authorize the use of off-highway motor vehicles on county roads owned or controlled by the County.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Chaves County Board of Commissioners as the governing body of Chaves County that:

I. OPERATING RESTRICTIONS

A person may operate an off-highway motor vehicle on any road or street owned or controlled by Chaves County, provided:

- 1. The vehicle has one or more headlights and one or more taillights that comply with the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Act ("ACT").
- 2. The vehicle has brakes, mirrors and mufflers.
- The operator has a valid driver's licenses or permits as required under the Motor Vehicle Code and Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Safety Permits as required under the ACT.
- 4. The operator is insured in compliance with the Mandatory Financial Responsibility Act.
- 5. The operator of the vehicles is wearing eye protection that complies with the ACT.
- 6. If the operator is under eighteen years of age, the operator must wear a safety helmet that complies with the ACT.

II. PROHIBITED AREAS

- A. A person shall not operate an off-highway motor vehicle on any:
 - Limited access highway or freeway,

2. Any incorporated municipality unless the municipality has adopted an ordinance or resolution authorizing the use of an off-highway motor vehicle in its incorporated municipal limits.

III. STREET CROSSING

Off-highway motor vehicles may cross streets or highways, except limited access highways or freeways, if the crossings are made after coming to a complete stop prior to entering the road way. Off-highway motor vehicles shall yield the right of way to oncoming traffic and shall begin a crossing only when it can be executed safely and then cross in the most direct manner as close to a perpendicular angle as possible.

IV. SPEED LIMIT

- a. The speed limit for an off-highway vehicle operating on a paved county road is 45 mph or the posted speed limit, whichever is less.
- b. The speed limit for an off-highway vehicle operating on a gravel or dirt county road is whatever is reasonable for the condition of the road, but not greater than 45 mph.
- V. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this Ordinance.

VI. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be effective June 21, 2018.

ORDINANCE NO. 0-101

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PROMOTION OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND COMMERCE BY REGULATION OF CERTAIN INVOLUNTARY PAYMENTS REQUIRED OF EMPLOYEES IN CHAVES COUNTY

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this Ordinance to provide that no employee covered by the National Labor Relations Act need join or pay dues to a union, or refrain from joining a union, as a condition of employment; and provide certain penalties for violation of those employment rights; and

WHEREAS, public employees are not covered by the National Labor Relations Act, and therefore are not affected by this ordinance;

WHEREAS, certain employers in the construction trades have expressed that "hiring halls" run by the construction trades provide certain benefit to them by facilitating hiring qualified employees, agreements with those employers to hire employees referred through those hiring halls is not prohibited by this ordinance;

WHEREAS, the County of Chaves County desires to promote growth and economic development within its legal boundaries, directly and in cooperation with public and private entities promoting Chaves County and its resources, its people and its many geographical and cultural advantages; and

WHEREAS, Chaves County and its residents compete for the expansion of employment opportunities with other cities, counties and states whose citizens have adopted similar right to work legislation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the New Mexico Constitution, this Body is tasked with and empowered to enact ordinances of local self-governance, including for the protection and convenience of the public, to encourage local commerce; and protect the rights and well-being of its citizens, and

WHEREAS, we hereby find and determine that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Chaves County to promote and encourage the growth of products, services and employment opportunities to its citizens, and for the protection and convenience of the public and the expansion of the tax base, that we should protect employees' right to choose employment without restraint or

coercion regarding the payment of mandatory dues, fees or other payments to a labor organization as a condition of that employment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNTY OF CHAVES COUNTY, STATE OF NEW MEXICO, THAT NO EMPLOYEE WITHIN ITS INCORPORATED BOUNDARIES WHO IS COVERED BY THE NATIONAL LABOR RELATIONS ACT NEED JOIN OR PAY DUES TO A UNION, OR REFRAIN FROM JOINING A UNION, AS A CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT; AND CERTAIN PENALTIES SHALL BE PROVIDED FOR VIOLATION OF THOSE EMPLOYMENT RIGHTS:

Section 1. <u>Authority.</u> This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority granted to this body by the New Mexico Constitution, as a political subdivision of the State, in accordance with the laws set forth in the New Mexico Revised Statutes and the laws of the United States of America. The Chaves County Board of Commissioners (the "Commission") is authorized to adopt this ordinance pursuant to the New Mexico Constitution and NMSA 1978 §§ 4-37-I et seq. The intent of this Ordinance is to be applied throughout the County of Chaves County, and all governmental entities subsumed thereunder, included.

Section 2. Declaration of public policy. It is hereby declared to be the public policy of the Chaves County in order to ensure individual freedom of choice in the pursuit of employment, for the protection and convenience of its citizens who desire the broadest choice of employment opportunities, to permit its citizens to choose to increase their real take home pay by decreasing mandatory payroll deductions in order to stimulate savings and economic growth, and to encourage an employment climate conducive to the promotion of the County to locate, expand or maintain large and small businesses for the economic development, growth and preservation of the community, including recruiting new businesses to the community, that the right to work shall not be subject to undue restraint or coercion. The right to work shall not be infringed or restricted in any way based on membership in, affiliation with, or financial support of a labor organization.

Section 3. Terms. The terms "employee," "employer," "labor organization," and "person" as used in this Ordinance shall have the same meanings as defined by the National Labor Relations Act, 29 U.S.C. §§ 151 et seq.

Section 4. <u>Freedom of choice guaranteed. discrimination prohibited.</u> No person covered by the National Labor Relations Act shall be required as a condition of employment or continuation of employment:

- (A) to resign or refrain from voluntary membership in, voluntary affiliation with, or voluntary financial support of a labor organization;
 - (B) to become or remain a member of a labor organization; or
- (C) to pay any dues, fees, assessments, or other charges of any kind or amount to a labor organization; or
- (D) to pay to any charity or other third party, in lieu of such payments, any amount equivalent to or a pro-rata portion of dues, fees, assessments, or other charges regularly required of members of a labor organization.

Section 5. <u>Voluntary deductions protected</u>. It shall be unlawful to deduct from the wages, earnings, or compensation of an employee any union dues, fees, assessments, or other charges to be held for, transferred to, or paid over to a labor organization, unless the employee has first presented, and the employer has received, a signed written authorization of such deductions, which authorization may be revoked by the employee at any time by giving written notice of such revocation to the employer, unless the employee has expressly waived such right of revocation in the express terms of an otherwise lawful "dues check-off" card. In the invent of ambiguity in the meaning of the dues check off language, the burden of proving notice, and assent shall be on the party seeking enforcement of the dues check off agreement.

Section 6. Agreements in violation. and actions to induce such agreements. declared illegal. Any agreement, understanding, or practice, written or oral, implied or expressed, between any labor organization and employer that violates the rights of employees as guaranteed by provisions of this Ordinance is hereby declared to be unlawful, null and void, and of no legal effect.

Section 7. <u>Coercion and intimidation prohibited</u>. It shall be unlawful for any person, labor organization, or officer, agent or member thereof, or employer, or officer thereof, by any threatened or actual intimidation of an employee or prospective employee, or an employee's or prospective employee's parents, spouse, children, grand-children, or any other persons residing in the employee's or prospective employee's home, or by any damage or threatened damage to an employee's or prospective employee's property, to compel or attempt to compel such employee to join, affiliate with, or financially support a labor organization or to refrain from doing so, or otherwise forfeit any rights as guaranteed by provisions of this

Ordinance. It shall also be unlawful to cause or attempt to cause an employee to be denied employment or discharged from employment because of support or nonsupport of a labor organization by inducing or attempting to induce any other person to refuse to work with such employees.

Section 8. Penalties. Anyone violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction be subject to a fine not exceeding \$300.00 or confinement in a County detention facility for a period not exceeding 90 days, or both such fine and confinement.

Section 9. Right of Enforcement. Any individual harmed as a result of any violation or threatened violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall have a right of redress in the appropriate Court of competent jurisdiction to enjoin further violations, and to recover the actual damages sustained, together with the cost of the recovery, including a reasonable attorney's fee. Such remedies shall be independent of and in addition to the penalties and remedies prescribed in other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 10. <u>Duty to investigate</u>. It shall be the duty of the Sheriff of Chaves County to investigate complaints of violation or threatened violations of this Ordinance and to take all means at his/her command to ensure the effective enforcement of this Ordinance.

Section 11. Prospective application. The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to all contracts entered into after the effective date of this Ordinance by employers and labor organizations for application to employees within our jurisdiction, and shall apply to any renewal or extension of any existing contract.

Section 12. Effective date. This Ordinance proposed for adoption shall take effect 30 days upon approval by the Chaves County Board of County Commissioners.

Section 13. <u>Severability clause</u>. If any provision of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person, entity or circumstances, shall be invalid or unenforceable to any extent, the remainder of this Ordinance, and the application of such provision to other person, entities or circumstances, shall not be affected thereby and shall be enforced to the greatest extent permitted by law.

Section 14. Repealer clause. All prior Orders, Resolutions or Ordinances or parts thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the powers granted to the County by the State of New Mexico. This ordinance shall be effective June 21, 2018.

ORDINANCE #44

CHAVES COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY USE PERMIT Amended December 18, 2014

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Commissioners of Chaves County:

SECTION 1 - TITLE

This Ordinance will be known as the Chaves County Right-of-Way Use Permit Ordinance.

SECTION II - GENERAL POLICY

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person to make any excavation, pavement cut, or remove pavement from any County street or road right-of-way without first applying for and securing a permit from Chaves County, complying fully with all provisions of this Ordinance.
- B. Should any conflict exist between the provisions of this Ordinance and other applicable laws the most stringent regulation shall apply.

SECTION III - DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following terms, phrases, words and their derivations will have the meaning given herein.

- A. "Applicant" means any person required to apply for a permit.
- B. "County" means that portion of the geographic limits of Chaves County lying outside the boundaries of all incorporated municipalities.
- C. "Excavation" means a hole, trench, ditch, or depression in a public place resulting from the removal or moving the pavement, dirt, or other material by a person.
- D. "Facility" means any pipe, pipeline, tube, main, service vent, vault, manhole, meter, regulator, valve, conduit, pole, pole line, anchor, cable, structure or object of any kind of character whether enumerated herein or not which is or may be lawfully constructed, left, placed or maintained upon, along, across, under, or over any public place.
- E. "Person" means an individual, estate, trust, receiver, cooperative association, club, corporation, franchised utility company, firm, partnership, joint venture, syndicate or other entity.
- F. "Permittee" means a person whose application has been approved by Chaves County.

- G. "Public Place" means all property owned or maintained by the County including but not limited to streets, highways, alleys, planes, sidewalks, plazas, parks, easements, right-of-ways, curbs, and drainage ways.
- H. "Right-of-Way" means any County land or other place, property or interest therein, usually in a strip, acquired for or devoted to transportation purposes.
- I. "Substructure" means any facility located below the surface of any public place.
- J. "Substructure opening" means an opening into a lawful substructure, the top of which is flush with the adjoining surface of a public place and which is so constructed as to permit frequent openings without injury or damage to a public place and without removal of pavement, dirt, or other material.

SECTION IV - PERMITS AND APPROVALS

- A. Except as hereinafter provided in this Section, and in Section V of this Ordinance, no person may commence any excavation in any County street or road right-of-way unless a permit for such excavation is first obtained from the County. The permit will be valid for ninety (90) days, at which time it will expire. Construction commenced after the expiration date shall be in violation of this Ordinance, unless a written request for extension of the termination date has been filed and approved by the Road Superintendent.
- B. A permit shall be required for excavation of a substructure opening.
- C. A permit shall be required for aerial crossings of County right-of-ways.
- D. No permit is required for entry into an excavated substructure opening, unless the substructure is located where a traffic hazard can exist.

SECTION V - APPLICATION

Every person required to obtain a permit by this Ordinance must make application therefore to the County Road Superintendent or his designated representative.

- A. The Application shall state:
 - 1. The name, telephone number, address, and place of business of the applicant, name of contact person;
 - 2. A description of the location and dimensions of the proposed excavation, including a plan view and cross-section view of the proposed project;
 - 3. The method by which the proposed excavation will be accomplished;

- 4. The purpose of the facility to be installed therein;
- 5. The estimated length of time required to complete the work, including backfilling and removal of all obstructions, materials and debris, and the restoration of the surface. A duly issued permit shall be the authority of the applicant to excavate in the public place for which the permit is granted.
- B. The application shall be reviewed by the County Road Superintendent. Applications for driveways, drainage culverts, irrigation lines, utility distribution and service lines and associated facilities shall be subject to approval by the County Road Superintendent. All other applications shall be subject to approval by the Chaves County Board of Commissioners.
- C. All road crossings on paved roads shall be performed by boring or jacking rather than excavating. All crossings shall be clearly marked.

SECTION VI - LIABILITY

All persons required to apply for a permit under this Ordinance shall provide a certificate of insurance satisfactory to the County showing that he/she has such insurance as will protect him/her from claims or damages because of bodily injury, including death, to his/her employees and all other; and from claims for damage to property, any and all of which may arise out of or result from his/her operations, including completed operations, in connection with the making of an excavation or the entering into a substructure opening, whether such operations be by himself or any subcontractor or anyone directly or indirectly employed by him.

SECTION VII - PERMIT WARRANTY AND RESTRICTIONS

- A. The permittee is required to correct incomplete or defective materials and workmanship performed under each permit.
- B. The permittee must restore the street sub-base and surface to its original condition. Upon failure of the permittee to do so within twenty-four (24) hours after notice from the County, the County may cause to have such work done, and the cost thereof charged to the permittee.
- C. The permittee must take appropriate measures to maintain safe and adequate passage of vehicle and pedestrian traffic as required by the County.
- D. In the event that the permittee causes damage to the existing utilities (and for this purpose, pipe coating or other encasement or other devices are considered a part of the utility). The owners must be notified immediately, and the damage repaired or paid for by the permittee. Further, the permittee is responsible for the proper installation of any diversion or ponding devices necessary for protection of property and structures, and shall be responsible for repair or payment of damages caused to property or structures by permittee's failure to properly provide such devices.

E. The permittee shall keep all roadways and right-of-ways usable and in safe condition. All traffic control plans and construction signing shall be reviewed and approved by the Road Operations Director and shall be in accordance with the MUTCD (Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, published by the Federal Highway Administration).

SECTION VIII - CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS

- A. The permittee prior to making any excavation or paving cut, shall adequately barricade the area to be excavated and shall comply with the Uniform Traffic Code of the State of New Mexico.
- B. All material excavated must be piled and maintained so as to not endanger the public. In order to expedite the flow of traffic or keep dirt and dust from spreading or flying the permittee must use guards or other methods and/or shall water the excavated material. The permittee shall remove all rubbish, excess earth, rock and other debris resulting from the excavation work immediately upon completion of backfilling as required by Section VII. Upon failure to do so within twenty-four(24)hours after notice from the County may do so and charge the cost to the permittee.
- C. In the event grade changes are made in the County road or the County right-of-way is widened or realigned which necessitates relocation of any installation, permittee upon receiving written notice from the County, will contact the Road Department to coordinate relocation of his/her facilities. The relocation shall be done by the permittee within a reasonable time (usually sixty (60) days) and at his/her own expense. If the permittee is unable or refuses to comply, the County may cause the work to be done with the permittee paying the cost thereof.
- D. The County will endeavor to give the applicants sufficient notice of any proposed construction or maintenance work on either existing or newly acquired right-of-way that is likely to expose, cover up, or disturb any cable, pipeline or any tile line belonging to the permittee, in order that the permittee may arrange to protect his lines.
- E. The permittee will comply with the New Mexico "One Call System" and will have the log number given by "One Call" for underground utilities location on a project site during all construction work resulting from this permit.
- F. The permittee agrees to give the County at least four (4)days notice of its intention to start construction on the County right-of-way. Said notice shall be in writing to the County Road Superintendent.

- G. The depth requirements for all trenching and excavating shall be as follows:
 - 1. Gas lines shall be a minimum of four (4') feet in depth from the lowest point within the County right-of-way.
 - 2. Water lines shall be a minimum of two (2') feet in depth from the lowest point within the County right-of-way.
 - 3. All other lines shall be a minimum of two (2') feet in depth from the lowest point within the County right-of-way.
 - 4. Exceptions to the minimum depths may be authorized by the Road Superintendent or his representative.
- H. All trenching and excavations under County roadways shall be sleeved.

SECTION IX - BACKFILLING

Unless specifically exempted in writing, any person who trenches or excavates within a public place for any purpose whatsoever is required to backfill a trench or excavation as follows:

- A. All backfilling of trenches shall be thoroughly compacted in layers of six inches (6") or less in depth to a ninety-five percent (95%) maximum density. Backfilling of trenches within the right-of-way but not under the travelled road, shall be compacted sufficiently to avoid settlement. All work shall be done in a workman-like manner and the ground left in neat condition. All work must be satisfactory to the Road Superintendent or his designated representative.
- B. Backfill and compaction inspections shall, to the extent practical, be made by the County.
- C. In the event the compacted backfill fails to meet the density requirements of this Section or otherwise fails as evidenced by settlement of the trench or excavation the County may order the faulty backfill material removed, replaced and recompacted to the required density specified herein; and the County may also order the replacement of all pavement destroyed or damaged as a result of the backfill failure settlement. The cost incurred by the County shall be paid by the permittee.

SECTION X - INSPECTIONS

- A. The County may make such inspections as are reasonably necessary in the enforcement of this Ordinance.
- B. Acceptance or approval of ditching, excavation, backfilling, and restoration of surface by the County does not prevent the County from asserting claim against the permittee for incomplete or defective workmanship or materials. The presence of a representative of the County during the performance of the work does not relieve the permittee of his responsibilities hereunder.
- C. The permittee or his/her representative, subcontractor, shall have a copy of the permit on site at all time during construction for review by the Road Superintendent or his representative.

SECTION XI - FEES

- A. The fee will cover the permit, plan checking, and inspection.
 - B. The amount of the permit fee will be computed as follows:
 - 1. There shall be a minimum fee for each permit in the amount of \$50.00. This includes one installation up to ten feet long, off of the traveled roadway.
 - 2. Each additional foot of underground installation in a County maintained right-of-way shall be calculated as follows (based on project total feet):
 - a. 0 feet to 1,000 feet maximum at \$0.50 per foot.
 - b. 0 feet to 2,000 feet maximum at \$0.40 per foot.
 - c. 0 feet to 5,000 feet maximum at \$0.30 per foot.
 - d. 0 feet to 10,000 feet maximum at \$0.20 per foot.
 - e. Over 10,000 feet at \$0.10 per foot.
 - f. Installations in a non-maintained rightof- way shall not be assessed an additional fee in excess of the minimum permit fee.

- 3. Each additional foot of aerial installation at \$0.10 per foot.
- 4. Each excavation of a non-paved, maintained roadway at \$120.00 each.
- 5. Each jacking or boring under a maintained roadway at \$50.00 each.
- 6. Each excavation of a paved roadway at \$1,100.00 each.
- C. Payment shall be made in the form of a check, money order, or draft made payable to Chaves County.
- D. The County reserves the right to waive the fees on aerial crossings provided crossing does not affect the right-of-way.
- E. The County reserves the right to waive fees for entry into a substructure opening.

SECTION XII - DOUBLE FEES

Where work for which a permit is required is started prior to obtaining a permit, the fees specified above shall be doubled, but the payment of such doubled fees shall not relieve any persons from full compliance with the requirements of this Ordinance in the execution of the work nor from any other penalties provided by law.

SECTION XIII - PENALTY

In addition to any other liability imposed by law, any person who shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance may, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the County jail not to exceed ninety (90) days, or to both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the judge. Each day of violation shall be considered a separate offense.

SECTION XIV - REGULATIONS

The County may promulgate such rules and regulations as may be required to implement this Ordinance.

SECTION XV - SEVERABILITY

If any part of application of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of its provisions applicable to other situations or persons shall not be affected.

SECTION XVI - SUSPENSION OR CANCELLATION OF PERMIT

The County is authorized or empowered to suspend, cancel, or

withdraw any permit issued by the County for the performance of any work not being done in compliance with this Ordinance.

SECTION XVII - VARIANCES

- A. A variance will be considered should problems arise concerning compliance by the Permitee with this ordinance. A request for a variance must be submitted to the Road Department in writing, and set forth the problems encountered and justification for granting the request.
- B. The request for a variance shall be reviewed by the County Road Superintendent, subject to approval by the Chaves County Board of Commissioners.

SECTION XVIII - APPEALS

In the event any applicant is aggrieved by the refusal of the County to grant any permit, the denial of a request for time extension or the suspension, cancellation or withdrawal of any permit] pursuant to Section XVI, the applicant may, within ten (10) calendar days of the aggrieved action, submit to the County Road Superintendent a request for hearing in front of the Chaves County Road Committee. In the event the applicant aggrieved by the Road Committee's decision, the applicant may file a written notice of appeal to the Chaves County Board of Commissioners. The Notice of Appeal must be filed in the office of the County Clerk within ten (10) calendar days of the Road Committee's decision. The Chaves County Board of Commissioners shall consider the appeal within thirty (30) calendar days of its filing at the County Clerk's office.




